All we are and all we possess does not belong to us, it belongs to the Lord.

Do you realize that we cannot really give anything away that we possess?

When you finally and fully embrace the reality that God owns everything,
it immediately begins to loosen your grip on your possessions.

How can you know the difference between what you OWN and what you POSSESS?
You will take everything you own with you when you die!

The same possessions that can produce destructive/temporal and eternal outcomes
can also produce abundant blessings in both this life and the next.

Are you putting your trust in the size of your POSSESSIONS or in the size of your GOD?

It is much easier to give what doesn't belong to us. That is why the first step to generosity
is accepting God's ownership of all we possess.

Of all that God has entrusted to us to manage, our time is one of our most precious possessions.

So often we hold on to possessions like a toddler who has just learned the word MINE.

Have you found this to be true in your walk with the Lord?
The more you POSSESS the more you find yourself trusting Him LESS.

When we worry we unlock the door for the Robber to break in and steal our most valuable possessions –
our peace of mind and our joy in life.

Simplicity cultivates the art of letting go and de-attaching from possessions.
It brings with its practice, both freedom and generosity.

When we calculate what we are worth, are we looking at what we have here and now
or what we will have then and there?

Resist the temptation to inappropriately assume the throne
and play little gods over stuff that doesn't even belong to us.

When you consider yourself in the role of “manager” rather than “owner,”
how does this change how you view your stuff?

Are you a slave or the master of your things?
